General Warranty Deed.

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RECORDED
This Indenture, Made and entered into this 1st day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between Emma Bough Rice Childers and Arthur Bough her husband of Keystone part 1st of the first part, and Harve L. Hollingsworth of Broken Arrow part 4th of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The west half of the north east quarter of Section Twenty (20) Township eighteen (18) north Range Fourteen (14) east

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Emma Bough wife of the said Arthur Bough for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
