

General Warranty Deed.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 14th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between Emma Barnett, nee Corbrey and Joseph Barnett, her husband of Bald Hill, D.T. parties of the first part, and James H. Corbrey of Blackwell, D.T. part y of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party ies of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred 00/100 Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part y of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: North Half (1/2) and the South West quarter (1/4) of the South East quarter (1/4) of Section Seventeen (17) Township Nineteen (19) North and Range Thirteen (13) East, of the Canadian Base and Meridian containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less, according to the government survey.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Joseph Barnett Husband wife of the said Emma Barnett, nee Corbrey for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part y of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part y of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
