General Warranty Deed.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 4 day of September, one thousand nine hundred and 7 by and between Mary Sango single woman and W. R. Sitter of Muskogee, I.T. part y of the first part, and W. R. Sitter of Muskogee, I.T. part y of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and Twenty Five \$100 Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do es hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

E 1/2 of Section West 1/4 of section thirty two (32) Township nine-
teen (19) N. Range fourteen (14) East of Indian Base and miscellan in
Indian Territory, containing 80 acres more or less as the case
may be according to the U. S. survey thereof

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertain-
ing, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, W. R. Sitter wife of the said W. R. Sitter for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
