**General Warranty Deed.**

**This Indenture**, Made and entered into this 6th day of Sept., one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between Jack Lewis and Delilah Lewis, his wife of Ellis, I.T. parties of the first part, and A. L. Mc Lemore of Stone Bluff, I.T. party of the second part.

**Witnesseth**, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty hundred Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The northwest quarter of the southwest quarter and Lot six (6) of section twenty-five (25) Township seventeen (17) north, Range fourteen (14) East.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Delilah Lewis wife of the said Jack Lewis for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
