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## General Warranty Deed.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September, one thousand nine hundred and ~~even~~ by and between Lucy Holahata and of Sapulpa, Okla. part y of the first part, and The Olympia Oil Company of Muskogee, Okla. part y of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party y of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of \$500.00 Five Hundred Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do ~~do~~ hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part y of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the  Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All my right, title and interest in and to the following described land: - Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 and the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 30 Township 18 North and Range 13 East, being part of the allotment of my deceased husband to the said Holahata, who died August 11th 1907 leaving me his only heir.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same. The said grantor hereby covenants with the said party of the second part that the execution of these presents represents the promises of the said grantor and that the said party of the first part will warrant and defend the title thereto to the said party of the second part its successors and assigns of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part y of the second part, its successors, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
