

General Warranty Deed.

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This Indenture, Made and entered into this 2nd day of October, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between Isaac Johnson and Mary Johnson his wife of Greer Indian Territory part of the first part, and J. M. Webster of Broken Arrow Indian Territory part of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Twenty five Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The north east-quarter of the north west quarter of Section twelve (12) Township eighteen (18) north Range fourteen (14) east of the Indian base and meridian containing forty acres

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same, quit-claim the title to the same

And I, Mary Johnson wife of the said Isaac Johnson for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
