

# General Warranty Deed.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this fourteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between Henry & Sallie Morrison, <sup>sole heirs at law of Ann Morrison</sup> and of Fred. Ind. Ter. parties of the first part, and Thomas Blair of Broken Arrow Ind. Ter. part of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of (2500.) Twenty-five hundred Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situated in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The north-east quarter of section thirty-four (34) Township eighteen (18) north, and Range thirteen (13) east

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Sallie Morrison wife of the said Henry Morrison for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
