This Indenture, Made and entered into this 19th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between Robert M. Mitchell, and an unmarried man of Rollinsville, D.T. part of the first part, and Johnston Butterfield and James H. Tucker of Rollinsville, D.T. part of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred eighty-six Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: All of Lot five (5) in Block thirty-nine (39) in the town of Rollinsville, Indian Territory, according to the United States Government Plat and Survey thereof, together with all of the improvements of any kind or nature located thereon.

This deed is made subject to the payment by the parties of the second part of the appraisements due to the United States Government on this lot

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, _____ wife of the said _____ for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
