General Warranty Deed.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 12th day of October, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between C. S. Turley and Laura Turley of Broken Arrow, I.T. part 1st of the first part, and John W. Simmons of Fry, I.T. part 1st of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party C. S. Turley of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part C. S. Turley of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Broken Arrow Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South east quarter of the north west quarter and lots three & six of Section three in Township Seventeen north and Range Thirteen east of the Indian Base and Meridian in Indian Territory, containing One hundred Twenty & 94/100 acres more or less according to the U.S. survey thereof.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Laura Turley C. S. Turley wife of the said C. S. Turley for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party C. S. Turley of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party C. S. Turley of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
