Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and twenty Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The 9<sup>th</sup> E 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the N 9<sup>th</sup> 1/4 and the N 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the N 9<sup>th</sup> 1/4 all in Section twenty nine - 29 Township twenty (20) north Range 14 east of the Indian Meridian together with all improvements thereon

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same. all claims

And I, Laura Wright wife of the said Thomas Wright for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
