**Witnesseth**, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred Twelve <sup>30</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part y of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The west half 1/2 of the north west quarter 1/4 and the south east quarter 1/4 of the north west quarter 1/4 of Section thirty six (36) Township seventeen (17) North Range thirtieth (30) east of the Indian Base and meridian containing one hundred twenty (120) acres more or less, according to survey

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same. subject to agricultural lease of J. F. Warren for 17-07  
And I, wife of the said for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part y of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
