

General Warranty Deed.

 This Indenture, Made and entered into this eighth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between J. C. Wilson of Muskogee, Indian Territory and a single man of John Laacka single man part 1 of the first part, and of East St. Louis Ill. part 2 of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Forty hundred Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: North half and the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section ten township nineteen Range thirtieth

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, his wife of the said John Laacka for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
