General Warranty Deed.

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and no/100 Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter (1/4) of the northeast quarter (1/4) of the northeast quarter (1/4) of section five (5) township twenty two (22) north, range thirteen (13) east, containing ten acres, more or less.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Mary C. Jones wife of the said Cade Jones for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
