WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we James Nail and Ethel Nail
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty
DOLLARS, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George G. Bayne
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Our undivided one-fourth interest in and to the West
half of the Northeast quarter, and the Southeast
quarter of the Northeast quarter all in Section
34, Township 19 North, Range 13 East.

To have and to hold the same unto the said George G. Bayne and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant... with said George G. Bayne that we
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ethel Nail wife of the said James Nail
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George
G. Bayne all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
