KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we James Nail and Ethel Nail  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty-six Hundred  
DOLLARS,  
Receipt hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George G. Bayne  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Le reeks Nation  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
The S E 1/4 of N E 1/4 and all that part of the N E 1/4 of  
S E 1/4 lying north and east of a diagonal line  
from the NW corner to the S E corner of said  
N E 1/4 of S E 1/4, all in Sec. Three, Township 19, North  
Range 12 East and the West 2.50 acres of the North  
4.70 acres of Lot 2, Section 36 Township 19 North  
Range 12 East  
To have and to hold the same unto the said George G. Bayne and unto his  
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant & with said George G. Bayne that we  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ethel Nail wife of the said James Nail  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George  
G. Bayne all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
