do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said The August Land Co. its successors
and unto heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the described lot or parcel of ground
being situated in the Creek nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
The Northeast quarter of Section thirteen (13)
Township seventeen (17) North range fourteen (14)
East

To have and to hold the same unto the said The August Land Co. its successors
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.
Austin & hissoe do hereby covenant with said The August Land Co. that said lands are free from all incumbrances
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I Barney & hissoe wife of the said Austin & hissoe
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said The August Land Co.
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
