

WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.
WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Jessie L. Hollis and Solomon M. Hollis
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of

Sixteen Hundred
DOLLARS, Cash on hand paid to them by George W.
Stiles the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
and accepted

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George W. Stiles
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Leek Nation

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Beginning at a point 771 feet south of the
Quarter Section corner between Section Eleven (11) and Section Twelve (12) Township
Nineteen (19) North of Range Twelve (12) East and running thence on a
Magnetic Course South 74 Degrees West 44.4 feet to the left Bank of the
Arkansas River, thence down said bank to its intersection with the section
line between Section 11 and 12 Township (19) North of Range (12) East, thence
North along said section line to place of beginning being three Acres
more or less out of the South East corner of Section Eleven (11)
Township Nineteen (19) North of Range Twelve (12) East
To have and to hold the same unto the said George W. Stiles and unto his

heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant, with said George W. Stiles that they

will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. Except a Mortgage Note
of Two hundred Dollars in favor of Thomas W. Stiles, which parties
assumes and agrees to pay as part of the purchase price
And I, Solomon M. Hollis husband of the said Jessie L. Hollis

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George
W. Stiles all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
