KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Mary J. Crasson nee Abbott and Charles E. Crasson
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand n/100

DOLLARS,

The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
and to us in hand paid by S. L. Davis of Neasho Mo.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said S. L. Davis

and unto His heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Six (6) and the North Twenty One (21) Feet of
Lot Five (5) Block Sixty Four (64) and according
to the "Official Plat" and "Government Survey" of
the City of Zuba cloud. Zr.

To have and to hold the same unto the said S. L. Davis and unto His
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said S. L. Davis that They
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Charles E. Crasson wife of the said Mary J. Crasson
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said S. L. Davis
Davis all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
