do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. E. Lewis
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

South-west quarter (1/4) of section eleven (11) Township
eighteen (18) north range thirteen (13) east, being my
undivided interest in the allotment of my deceased
brother (George Simon).

To have and to hold the same unto the said E. E. Lewis and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. E. Lewis his heirs and assigns that
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Sam Simon wife of the said Sam Simon
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
