KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. A. Friend and Julia A. Friend  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred \$1500.00  
DOLLARS,

and paid by Mary E. Greene the  
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mary E. Greene  
and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Friend Addition to  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

the City of Tulsa western district of the Indian  
Territory, to-wit: all of Lot (5) five in Block  
(3) three and all of Lots (1) One and (2) two  
in Block (4) four as shown by the recorded  
plat of the Friend Addition to the City of  
Tulsa Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mary E. Greene and unto her  
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary E. Greene that they  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Julia A. Friend wife of the said J. A. Friend  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Mary A. G. all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
