WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we *Mamie Sullivan* a single woman called
 as *Mamie Perryman*
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *Five Thousand Five Hundred*
 DOLLARS,

to her and her heirs and assigns forever the receipt
 hereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said *Wm. Farmer*
 and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *Creek Nation*
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

the southeast quarter of the north east
quarter and Lots numbers one to four all in
Section twenty-five Township nineteen north range
twelve east-

To have and to hold the same unto the said *Wm. Farmer* and unto *his*
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *Wm. Farmer* that *she*
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, *wife of the said*
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
