WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.
WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Carrie V. Hansen and A. E. Hansen
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One
DOLLARS, and other good and valuable consideration

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Thuy M. KENZIE
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

30.20 ft of Lot 3 in Block 3 and no 46 2/3 ft
of Lot 4 in Block 3 in the City of North
Chulsa Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Thuy M. KENZIE and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Thuy M. KENZIE that we
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, A. E. Hansen husband of the said Carrie V. Hansen
Thuy M. KENZIE for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Thuy M. KENZIE all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
