WARRANTY DEED *5641*
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.
WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Wallace Mitchell and his wife Mary Mitchell, Wallace Mitchell being dower holder, and his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) Dollars to us in DOLLARS,

hand paid by Henry Decrest of County of receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Henry Decrest and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all the west 1/4 of the south east quarter of section nine (9) and the north west quarter of the south east quarter of section nine (9) township nineteen (9) north and range thirteen (13) east lying 20 acres of land.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Henry Decrest and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Henry Decrest that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary Mitchell wife of the said Wallace Mitchell or Worley for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Henry Decrest all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
