do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ella Brittonand unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the West

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot twenty six (26) in Block two (2) in the Oklahoma Addition
to the town of Tulsa Indian Territory, this deed is given in correction
of a former deed dated Mch 11-1907 filed for record March 12-07
in Book 10 Page 249 from same grantors to same grantee wherein
the description was incomplete wherein it describes the lot as number
twenty in writing and number (26) in figures.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ella Britton and unto her
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ella Britton that W.E.

will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Henry A. Kreager ^{Husband} of the said Mary D. Kreager

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
