KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Cheley Starr and
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.00)
 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid the receipt of which I hereby
acknowledge

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Oscar K. Eysenbach
 and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The West Half (1/2) of the Northeast quarter (1/4) of Section Twelve
Township eighteen north Range Twelve (12) East West Half (1/2) of the
Northwest quarter (1/4) of the South East quarter (1/4) of Section sixteen (16)
Township nineteen (19) North Range Twelve (12) East containing one
hundred acres more or less and being the allotment of Emma Starr,
deceased of whom the grantor is the sole heir

To have and to hold the same unto the said Oscar K. Eysenbach and unto his
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Oscar K. Eysenbach that I
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
