DOLLARS, to us paid cash in hand by William M. Favel receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said William M. Favel
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the
Western District of the Indian Territory, ~~to wit:~~ in the Creek Nation, to wit:
All of our interest in the West 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec 21 & the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 & the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 Sec 22 Twp 19 N. & Range 13 E. being the allotment of my daughter Hattie, & my former wife Jim Hoker Emarthla, both now deceased.

To have and to hold the same unto the said William M. Favel and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William M. Favel that we
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. we hereby declare that
we have never made a deed to anyone else.
And I, Mary Emarthla wife of the said Abram Emarthla

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
William M. Favel all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
