 WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.  
 WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we E. G. Wickizer and Lillie M. Wickizer  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Three Hundred & 00/100  
 DOLLARS, in hand paid by Robert L. Voris and Mary M. Voris, the  
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Robert L. Voris and Mary M. Voris  
 and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the  
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The East Half of the Northwest quarter, and the Southwest quarter  
of the Northwest quarter of Section Twenty one (21) Township  
nineteen (19) North Range Thirteen (13) East, containing 1.25  
acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Robert L. Voris and Mary M. Voris and unto their  
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Robert L. Voris and Mary M. Voris that we  
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lillie M. Wickizer wife of the said E. G. Wickizer

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
Robert L. Voris and Mary M. Voris all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
