KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Clifton C. Drew and his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred Sixty (\$1860.00) DOLLARS, in hand paid

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Emma Drew and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

an undivided one-half interest in and to the west one half (W³) of the northwest quarter (NW⁴) of Section nineteen (19) Township nineteen (19) N. Range thirteen (13) East.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Emma Drew and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Emma Drew that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
