do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Oscar H. Eysenbach  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all my undivided one-fourth interest in and to the North half of  
the Northeast quarter of Section fifteen; and the Northeast 1/4 of the  
South East quarter of Section Four, all in Township 19 North Range 13 East  
the same being the surplus allotment of Sunday Grayson deceased.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Oscar H. Eysenbach and unto his  
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Oscar H. Eysenbach that they  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Menena Grayson wife of the said Buck Grayson  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Oscar H. Eysenbach all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
