 Silanie Gray deceased, all in Section (35) Township (18) north
 Range (13) East.

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. E. Rohde and unto his
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. E. Rohde that they
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Buck Grayson husband wife of the said W. E. Rohde
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
W. E. Rohde all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
