KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Anna Clendenen and William Clendenen
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Three Hundred
 DOLLARS, In hand paid by M. E. Haigh receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged and confirmed.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said M. E. Haigh
 and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) in Block one (1) in Lindsey's first addition to Tulsa
Indian Territory according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said M. E. Haigh and unto her
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said M. E. Haigh that we
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, William Clendenen ^{husband} of the said Anna
Clendenen for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
M. E. Haigh all my rights of ^{country} ~~dower~~ and homestead in and to the said lands.
