

WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Jay Forsythe and Jennie Forsythe
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00)
 DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Vona clay
 and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot Twelve (12) Block Thirteen (13) Lynch & Forsythe's addition
To Tulsa Ind Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Vona clay and unto her
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S with said Vona clay that they
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jennie Forsythe wife of the said Jay Forsythe
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Vona clay all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
