KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Silas Thurman and Maudie Evelyn Thurman
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and 00/100
 DOLLARS, in hand paid by M. B. Shultz the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said M. B. Shultz
 and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Osage Nation
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south one half of the northwest quarter and lot three (3) all
of Section Five (5) Township Eighteen (18) North and Range Thirteen
(13) E. 7 of the Indian Base & Meridian Indian Territory.

To have and to hold the same unto the said M. B. Shultz and unto his
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.
 And hereby covenant with said M. B. Shultz that we

will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims arising from the same
 And I, Maudie Evelyn Thurman wife of the said Silas Thurman

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

M. B. Shultz all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
