WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Harriett Morris widow and T. S. French
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of thirteen hundred and forty

DOLLARS,

in hand paid by John S. French the receipt of which is
herby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John S. French

and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Osage Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The north one half (1/2) of lot one in block 2nd (10)
described as follows beginning at the N.E. corner of said lot, thence in a
southwesterly direction parallel with Fifth St. 140 ft. to rear line of said
lot thence in a southeasterly direction along the rear line of said lot 50 ft. thence in
an North easterly direction, parallel with the North line of said lot 140 ft. to property
line on North Cheyenne St. thence in an Northwesterly direction 50 ft. parallel to
North Cheyenne St. to point of beginning, said lot situated in the Town of Tulsa
and according to the Government survey thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said John S. French and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John S. French that I

will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Harriett Morris wife of the said John S. French

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
