

WARRANTY DEED 6/19/1
 WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Henry Lytal and Rena M. Lytal
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Eight Hundred
 DOLLARS,

in hand paid by Charles Haley, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Charles Haley
 and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot One (1) in Block Thine (5) in the Friend & Gillette
Addition to the Town of Tulsa.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Charles Haley and unto his
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Charles Haley that we
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Rena M. Lytal wife of the said Henry Lytal
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Charles
Haley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
