KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. B. Bain of Shawnee, and W. A. Wood a single person named man  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred fifty and no/100  
DOLLARS, to him paid cash on hand, the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged, as received from W. A. Wood of  
Shawnee, Indian Territory  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. A. Wood  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Shawnee nation  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all and entire of lots number fifteen (15) sixteen (16)  
seventeen (17), eighteen (18), nineteen (19) twenty (20), twenty one  
(21) and twenty two, in block number thirty three, in  
the town of Shawnee Indian Territory, according to  
the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. A. Wood and unto his  
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. A. Wood that he  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, W. A. Wood wife of the said W. A. Wood  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. A. Wood  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
