

WARRANTY DEED 6204

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Mary E. Leaman and Charles W. Leaman
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand (\$3000.)
 DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John J. Henderson
 and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all lots numbered three and four of the
south side of lot numbered two (2) all in Block
numbered Eleven (11) of Lindsey's second addition in
the North east Quarter of the North east Quarter
Section Eleven Township 19 Range 12 East.

To have and to hold the same unto the said John J. Henderson and unto his
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John J. Henderson that they
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Charles W. Leaman husband wife of the said Mary E. Leaman
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John J.
Henderson all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
