KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Lafayette W. Servey and Daisy C. Servey
of Oklahoma, Indian Territory, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and fifty (\$150.00)
DOLLARS, to us in hand paid by J. B. Katschorn, of Ballinsville, Indian Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. B. Katschorn,
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot numbered, Two (2) in Block numbered, Twenty-six (26) of the town
of Ballinsville, according to the official recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. B. Katschorn and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said J. B. Katschorn that
we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
And I, Daisy C. Servey wife of the said Lafayette W.
Servey for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
J. B. Katschorn all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
