

WARRANTY DEED 6218
 WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.
 WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Phoebe B. Trusler and Frank Trusler, her husband
 do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ralea F. Morley and Augusta M. Morley and
 the survivors of them and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots Three (3) and Four (4) in Section Two (2), Township Seventeen (17)
North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, according
to the United States survey thereof, containing 81.92 acres, more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ralea F. Morley and Augusta M. Morley and the survivors of them
 and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ralea F. Morley and Augusta M. Morley and the survivors of them that we
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Frank Trusler, husband wife of the said Phoebe B. Trusler

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Ralea F. Morley and Augusta M. Morley and the survivors of them all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
