KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we W. S. Hall and Stattie M. Hall
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of six thousand (\$6000.00)
DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. J. Mitchell
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa,
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot One (1) of Block One Hundred & Twenty Five (125) of the City
of Tulsa, according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. J. Mitchell and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant we with said Mitchell that we
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Stattie M. Hall wife of the said W. S. Hall

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
J. J. Mitchell and his heirs all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
