KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Lila D. Lindsay and L. M. Lindsay her husband
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred and Twenty
DOLLARS, to us in hand paid by Ethel Davis the receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ethel Davis
 and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Western
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: lots eight (8) and nine (9) and the north twelve feet
of lot ten (10) in Block Thirteen (13) in "Lindsay Second Addition" to the city of Tulsa
and ten said lots and parcels of lots herein above described being One Hundred
and twelve feet wide along South Guthrie Avenue and One Hundred and
Forty feet long along Lyne Avenue. The above described lots and parcels
of lots being also a portion of the "Surplus allotment" of the said Lila D.
Lindsay. The above described lots and parcels of lots are in accordance with a
certain map of said city and recorded in Book 7 page 641 in the Recorder's Office
in the City of Tulsa
 To have and to hold the same unto the said Ethel Davis and unto her

heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ethel Davis that they
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. M. Lindsay wife of the said Lila D. Lindsay
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ethel
Davis her heirs and assigns forever all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
