KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That *Isabelle Barker* over the age of 21 years
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *Seven + 54/100*
DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said *b. b. Sigler*
and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *Seeks Nation*
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South five (5) acres of N W 9. 74 a cross of Lot -
No Two (2) Section five (5) Township Eighteen V 8 N
Range Thirteen (13) E

To have and to hold the same unto the said *b. b. Sigler* and unto *his*
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *b. b. Sigler* that *she*
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I *Isabelle Barker* wife of the said *b. b. Sigler*
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *b. b. Sigler*
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
