KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Maggie Williams ne Roach
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred no
DOLLARS, The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
and to me in hand paid R.E. Lynch

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said R.E. Lynch
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee nation,
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The north east gr. of the south east gr. and north west gr. of the south
east gr. of the south east gr. sec. fifteen (15) Township Twenty (20) N. Range
Thirteen (13) E. Cherokee nation, I.T.

To have and to hold the same unto the said R.E. Lynch and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R.E. Lynch that they
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I Maggie Williams ne Roach wife of the said R.E. Lynch
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands
