MORTGAGE WITH POWER OF SALE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Louis S. Billings an unmarried man for and in consideration of ONE DOLLAR to him in hand paid, and the premises hereinafter set forth do hereby grant, bargain and sell unto The Commercial National Bank of

Muskogee Indian Territory, and unto its successors and assigns, forever, the following property situated in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, to-wit: The Northwest (NW 1/4) Quarter of Southeast (SE 1/4) Quarter of Sec. Twenty-nine (29) Township Twenty-two (22), Range Thirteen (13) being forty acres.

To have and to hold the same to the said The Commercial National Bank its successors or assigns, together with all and singular the appurtenances and improvements thereunto belonging; and I hereby covenants with the said The Commercial National Bank that I will forever warrant and defend the title to said property against all lawful claims.

And I wife of the said do hereby release unto the said all my right and dower in and to said lands. This sale is on condition that:

Whereas the said Louis S. Billings is justly indebted to the said The Commercial National Bank in the sum of Three hundred ten 00/100 (\$310.00) DOLLARS evidenced by promissory note dated June 17, 1907,

for Three hundred ten 00/100 Dollars (\$ 310.00) payable to the order of The Commercial National Bank Ninety days after date, executed by Louis S. Billings with interest at eight per cent per annum after maturity.

First parties agree to keep the buildings on the above premises constantly insured against loss by fire and tornado in a sum not less than \$ none, and loss, if any payable to the second party, as interest may appear at that time, and policies delivered to said second party, and to keep all taxes paid.

Now, if said first parties, or any one of them, shall pay said moneys at the time and in the manner aforesaid, then the above conveyance shall be null and void. And in case of non-payment of the same or any part thereof, or failure to keep said insurance or tax agreement, then the whole shall be at once due and payable and the said grantee or its assignee, agent or attorney in fact, shall have power to sell said property at public sale, to the highest bidder for cash, at the front door of the U. S. Court House, Muskogee, Indian Territory, public notice of the time and place of said sale having been first given thirty days, by advertising in some newspaper published in said city or by ten printed or written hand bills posted in ten public places in said city, at which sale said grantee or its assignee, agent or attorney in fact, may bid and purchase as any third person might do. And hereby authorize the said grantee or its assigns to convey said property to any one purchasing at said sale; and the recitals of this deed of conveyance shall be taken as prima facie true. And the proceeds of said sale shall be applied, first, to all costs and expenses attending said sale; second, to the payment of said debt and interest; and the remainder, if any, shall be paid to said grantor. The appraisalment and the right of redemption allowed by law are hereby expressly waived.
