

MORTGAGE WITH POWER OF SALE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Willie H Booth a widow of Tulsa County Oklahoma for and in consideration of ONE DOLLAR to him in hand paid, and the premises hereinafter set forth do hereby grant, bargain and sell unto H. H. Forbes of Nowata County Kansas of Indian Territory, and unto his successors and assigns, forever, the following property situated in the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma to wit: The South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section twenty one Township eighteen North and Range fourteen East of the Indian Base and Meridian

To have and to hold the same to the said H. H. Forbes him

successors or assigns, together with all and singular the appurtenances and improvements thereunto belonging;

and I hereby covenants with the said H. H. Forbes that I will forever warrant and defend the title to said property against all lawful claims.

all my right and dower in and to said lands. This

Whereas the said Willie H Booth is justly indebted to the said H. H. Forbes

in the sum of Five hundred (\$500)

DOLLARS evidenced by promissory note dated November 25th 1907

for Five hundred \$500 Dollars (\$) payable to the order of H. H. Forbes, three years after date

Days after date, executed by Willie H Booth

with interest at 8% per cent per annum after maturity. date

First parties agree to keep the buildings on the above premises constantly insured against loss by fire and tornado in a sum not less than \$, and loss, if any payable to the second party, as interest may appear at that time, and policies delivered to said second party, and to keep all taxes paid.

Now, if said first parties, or any one of them, shall pay said moneys at the time and in the manner aforesaid, then the above conveyance shall be null and void. And in case of non-payment of the same or any part thereof, or failure to keep said insurance or tax agreement, then the whole shall be at once due and payable and the said grantee or its assignee, agent or attorney in fact, shall have power to sell said property at public sale, to the highest bidder for cash, at the front door of the Court house at Tulsa Oklahoma public notice of the time and place of said sale having been first given thirty days, by advertising in some newspaper published in said city or by ten printed or written hand bills posted in ten public places in said city, at which sale said grantee or its assignee, agent or attorney in fact, may bid and purchase as any third person might do. And I hereby authorize the said grantee or its assigns to convey said property to any one purchasing at said sale; and the recitals of this deed of conveyance shall be taken as prima facie true. And the proceeds of said sale shall be applied, first, to all costs and expenses attending said sale; second, to the payment of said debt and interest; and the remainder, if any, shall be paid to said grantor. The appraisalment and the right of redemption allowed by law are hereby expressly waived.
