do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. O. Dickenson  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Seherokee Nation  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The west one-half of the south-west quarter  
of the south-west quarter, and the south-west  
quarter of section thirty two (32) Township Twenty (20)  
North, Range Thirteen (13) East, containing 30 acres  
more or less as the case may be.

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. O. Dickenson and unto his  
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. O. Dickenson that They  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Buena V. Rasmus wife of the said Bascom P.  
Rasmus for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. O.  
Dickenson all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
