KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we L. A. Williams and Myrtle Williams
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred + fifty
DOLLARS,

in hand paid by Army Henry Aggers, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Army Henry Aggers
and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Neek Nation

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot No. Ten (10) in Block No. Two (2) of the
Stansberry Addition to the original town of
Ouba, Indian Territory. Said lot having a
frontage of 54 feet on South Boulder Avenue
with a uniform width of 54 feet to the alley
line; a distance of 130 feet

To have and to hold the same unto the said Army Henry Aggers and unto her
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Army Henry Aggers that we
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Myrtle Williams wife of the said L. A. Williams

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Army
Henry Aggers all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
