Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said A. F. Ault
 and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Osage Nation
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 4, and W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the
E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Four (4)
Township Eighteen (18) North of Range Thirteen (13)
East

 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

Ault all my rights of country dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
