

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. B. Wright and Rosa E. Wright  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand  
DOLLARS, (\$1,000.00) to us in hand paid by David Carmichael  
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said David Carmichael  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: an undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to the following described  
Block Two hundred two (202) in the City of Tulsa, containing thirty (30) and bounded as follows:  
Beginning at a point on the southerly side of Lot Four (4) in Block Two hundred two (202), fifty (50)  
feet from the southerly corner of said lot; thence in a northerly direction along a line  
parallel with the dividing line between lots three (3) and four (4) in said block two hundred  
two (202) a distance of one hundred forty (140) feet; thence in an easterly direction along  
the northerly side of said lots three (3) and four (4) a distance of one hundred (100) feet to  
a point; thence in a northerly direction along a line parallel with the dividing  
line between said lots three (3) and four (4) in Block Two hundred two (202) one  
hundred forty (140) feet to a point; thence in a westerly direction along the  
southerly side of said lots three (3) and four (4) to a point of beginning being one-  
half (1/2) interest in a plot of ground having a frontage of one hundred (100) feet on  
Twelfth Street and a depth of one hundred forty (140) feet to an alley with a  
uniform width of one hundred (100) feet.  
To have and to hold the same unto the said David Carmichael and unto his

heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said David Carmichael that we  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Rosa E. Wright wife of the said J. B. Wright  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said David  
Carmichael all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
