Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

of Section 15, and the W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the N W<sup>4</sup> of the N E<sup>4</sup>  
and the N E<sup>4</sup> of the N W<sup>4</sup> of Section 22, all in  
Township 15 north range 12 E
